Comparison of maarse- ' The Secretary stated that he has felt for some time that a monthly comparison of endorsements on retirement allowance checks with those appearing in the retirement files should be made. He stated that arrangements have now been made with the Continental Illinois

National Bank and Trust Company whereby an experienced payer would be available after banking hours to check each endorsement at the rate of low per check.
