The following regular Retirement applications were presented to the Committee at this meeting, as per attached List No. 76:

Eight from the Transportation Department, three from the Track Department, and one from the Accounting Department. The Secretary informed the Committee that John F. Coughlin who was granted Total and Permanent Disability benefits beginning August 1, 1947 became 65 years of age on January 23, 1948 and would be transferred to the Regular Retirement roll on February 1, 1948. This makes a total of 1,972 applications approved to date.

There were also 4 Total and Permanent Disability applications from the Transportation Department presented. This makes a total of 68 applications approved to date.

Mr. Bedore make a motion, seconded by Mr. Bernard that the 12 regular Retirement and the 4 Total and Permanent Disability applications be accepted. Motion passed.
