The 149th Meeting of the Retirement Allowance Committee was held October 16, 1961, in the Secretary's Office, Room 746 in the Merchandise Mart, and the following were in attendance:

The Chairman called the Meeting to order at 10:30 A.M.

On a motion by Mr. O'Connor, seconded by Mr. McNamara, the Minutes of the 148th Meeting held September 18, 1961, were unanimously approved as written.

The announcement of deaths reported since the last Meeting was made by the Secretary as per the attached listing.

The Secretary presented forty-five (45) applications for approval. Mr. McNamara made a motion that one of the applications for disability pension for Mary V. Winters be made retroactive to August 1, 1961. The motion was seconded by Mr. Parilla and unanimously approved. On a motion by Mr. O'Connor, seconded by Mr. Hastings, the Committee unanimously approved the 45 applications presented by the Secretary.

The Secretary reported that during the month, eleven (11) employes on Total and Permanent Disability, as per the attached listing, were examined by the Medical Department, or their records reviewed.

On a motion by Mr. McNamara, seconded by Mr. O'Connor, the refunds to be made October 31, 1961, as per attached report were unanimously approved.

The Secretary read a report of deposits, disbursements and investments during the month of September as per the attached report.

The Secretary read a report of Chicago Transit Authority bills totaling \$2,201.41, and miscellaneous bills amounting to \$515.26.


On a motion by Mr. McNamara, seconded by Mr. O'Connor, the Committee unanimously approved the payment of these bills.
